R. Janes, Chair- called meeting to order at 4:30pm.

I. OFFICE BUSINESS:

- <u>Discussed Trash and Recycling proposals.</u>
 - o G. Mello (attached) estimated 4.78 increase every year, and recycling costs will be reviewed monthly. Seale believes that the customer service Mello has been excellent over the last 25 years and it's hard to argue with that community service that Mello provides.
 - o JRM (attached). Skepticism with 10 year proposal, Janes believes this length of contract would not be beneficial to the Town. Curbside collection would include 1 automated cart for trash and recycling would remain a manual collection. Recycling numbers would be reviewed quarterly.
 - Covanta proposal (attached). Board discussed both the three year and the five year proposal options presented. Board weighed the pros and cons...and at the end of the day agreed that they felt more comfortable with the 3 year option.
 - Board review FAQ document on Auto Collection. Board discussed and made some decisions, however there are still several unknowns. Krafton will email FAQ to Mello for review and Board will review again at next meeting.
- <u>FY21 Budget.</u> Acceptance of the below proposals are subject to appropriation. Contracts will not be executed until the operating budget is approved by Town Meeting.

3 year – CPI 4% Fixed 1600 Trash Tons Estimated \$90 Tip Fee Per Ton

Total incinerator \$144,000

Janes called for roll call vote. 3-0-0 Unanimous to pursue the 3 year waste disposal with Covanta.

G. MELLO -

\$240,660 Automated Curbside (Trash and Recycling) 600 Recycling Tons Estimated \$110 Processing Fee Per Ton Estimated

Total curbside \$240,660 (includes carts) Total recycling \$66,000

Janes called for roll call vote. 3-0-0 Unanimous to remain with G. Mello as curbside hauler.
