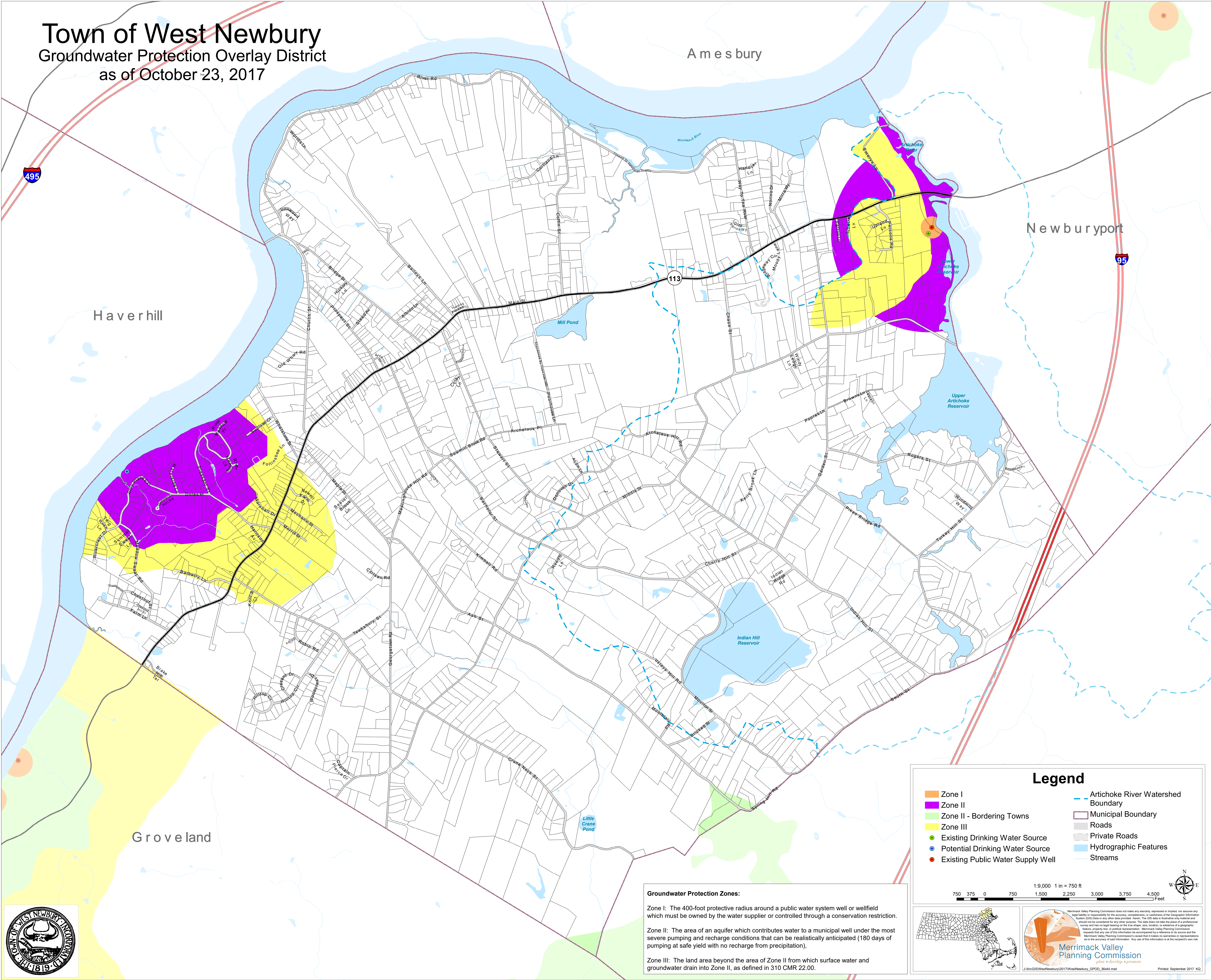


Town of West Newbury

Groundwater Protection Zones:

Zone I: The 400-foot protective radius around a public water system well or wellfield which must be owned by the water supplier or controlled through a conservation restriction.

Zone II: The area of an aquifer which contributes water to a municipal well under the most severe pumping and recharge conditions that can be realistically anticipated (180 days of pumping at safe yield with no recharge from precipitation),

Zone III: The land area beyond the area of Zone II from which surface water and groundwater drain into Zone II, as defined in 310 CMR 22.00.
