- June, 2019 at Town Hall: Arial photos starting in the 1930's with several pieces of land being specifically followed. Kick off will be on Friday evening and go thru Sunday. Will be open at designated hours throughout the month. Will need police officer for the kickoff night and some sponsors.
- Barns: a history of Barns in West Newbury. We asked them to help us to find barn venue for dance!!!
- August: Hand Tub Muster (WNBCC have thoughts about this happening on Field Day, (July 13, 2019) or some sort of sort of Harvest dinner in September which could be a farmer's market event.

Judy showed us draft of time line and it was unanimous that we at this point strictly adhere to it!!!

Sponsorships and town meeting are our immediate concerns. Judy and Steve will be all over sponsorships where good work has already been done.
