The need for emergency management planning - in the event of high wind, rain, etc. - was discussed. Security around wires was also discussed; an officer will be assigned to the stage area. Further research will be done into possible need for security around the projection area.

Greg discussed the idea of having a farmers' market instead of or in conjunction with a crafters display. The Committee agreed to bring ideas for possible participants to the next meeting for discussion.

Tri-fold Schedule - KC presented the schedule of events for Committee approval. After discussion around start times, the Committee unanimously approved the schedule.

WN Day at Fenway - The discussion around bus requirements was tabled until the next meeting.
