Deputy Evans reported to the BOFE: Lt. Marlowe & FF Donahue reported the windshield of E24 is cracked (Officer's side) and needs to be looked at. Not sure how it happened. They noticed it after a call on 5/9/19.

FF Corcoran is in the process of ordering orange lights for E23 (Rear Safety Light Bar).

Deputy Evans is looking into the new Squad that Springfield FD purchased recently and will report back to the BOFE.

Asst. Chief Jennell & Deputy Evans are looking into a "need vs. want" equipment list for the new Rescue-type vehicle.
