Non-Planned Residential Interconnection Upgrades

- Discussion about solar system vendors selling systems requiring IC upgrades.
 - Consumer was told after installation that inter-connection upgrade is needed (transformer?).
- Next step: Committee to monitor consider warning the town about such 'bait and switch' techniques from solar vendors, and overall interconnection upgrade costs (tentative on utility requirements).

Solar savings

Rick presented data regarding 12 month rolling savings.

Solar Feasibility Study

B2Q onsite draft survey ongoing.

Next step: B2Q to issue draft report from the onsite survey.

LED Street Light Replacement

- Recap: Merrimac Municipality Light Department offered to assist with LED replacements of the town's streetlights.
 - Note: West Newbury has approximately 134 streetlights.
 - Note: The current street light system costs the town approximately \$1100/month (leased)
- \$970/unit install cost → (\$130,000) Install cost + (\$9,000) LED procurement = (\$139,000) CAPEX. Operating expenses (OPEX) TBD. Expected annual cost savings is \$3000.
- Town currently spends \$13,200/year for lease and \$6,000/year in electricity for a total of \$19,200/year with current street lighting structure.
- Procurement process: Merrimac Municipality Light Department will source and acquire.
- Merrimac Municipality Light Department offered to assist with LED replacements of the town's streetlights.

Next Steps: Committee to talk to the selectmen on Monday, June 26th.

Municipal Aggregation

- Select board is pursuing the aggregation.
 - Contract signed with Colonial Power.

Next Steps: 1) Formulate which options the town wants. 2) Colonial to revert for next steps in the process.
