# West Newbury Finance Committee Minutes of the Meeting Wednesday, May 2, 2016

Chairman Codair called the Finance Committee to order at 7:05 p.m. in the second floor hearing room of the 1910 Building with Mr. DeLena, Ms. Grammer, Mr. McGrath, Mr. Phillips, and Mr. Winch present. Also present, Mr. Thomas Ellis, a citizen expressing interest in FinCom and requested to sit in.

There being no public comment, the Committee considered its agenda.

# **Transfer Requests**

Department of Public Works — \$25,000.00 Request for Departmental Transfer within Budget Representative — Mr. Gary Bill, Director, accompanied by Mr. Bertino, Finance Director Mr. Bertino introduced the transfer of funds. Mr. Bill requested a transfer of \$25,000.00 to Highway, Sidewalks, and Trees. Funds would be transferred from three sources:

Snow & Ice	\$7,000.00
Town Buildings	\$13,000.00
Road Machinery	\$5,000.00

Also stated on the transfer request of \$25,000.00 will cover street sweeping, beaver control, signs, tree work, and storm water control.

Chairman Codair stated \$13,000.00 represented a fair amount of money to be drawing off the town buildings line. Mr. Bill remarked the funds were mostly taken from utilities, which were significantly lower this year. Mr. McGrath queried Mr. Bill about DPW turn back funds for FY16. Mr. Bill replied the average is typically \$30.000.00 to \$40,000.00.

Mr. Bertino stated Snow and Ice were high last year. Mr. McGrath remarked Snow and Ice is usually financed with reserve funds. Mr. Bill stated this is the second time in his tenure he has transferred funds back from Snow and Ice.

FinCom approved the transfer, 6-0-0.

Chairman Codair signed the transfer request.

### Departmental Turn backs

Chairman Codair suggested to Mr. Bertino, it would be helpful to compile a list showing what each department turns back at the end of the fiscal year. Mr. Bertino stated, legally, turn backs must be processed by mid-July. He reported the final numbers should be available in August, 2016.

Article 20 — To see if the town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of \$25,000.00 to be deposited into a Municipal Buildings' Insurance Fund. By request of the Finance Director.

Mr. McGrath requested confirmation as to what are the deductibles for. Mr. Bertino replied the deductibles generally refer to building insurance. Mr. McGrath inquired about the town vehicles. He recalled a time when a dump truck overturned. Mr. Bertino replied vehicles are purchased with their own insurance to cover replacement costs.

# Update on Finance Department Software

Mr. Bertino reported he had received quotes from three main vendors. Since the quotes were received, one of the vendors was bought out and the software would only be supported for 18 months. Of the two remaining bids, one offered technology similar to the current software and the other was too expensive. The decision was to keep the status quo.
