7. Town Manager updates

We reviewed the Town's audit assessment. There were issues with the health insurance withholdings not reconciling from 2016-present to the tune of \$20,000. This discrepancy was caused by an individual not paying their portion of the health insurance obligation. This issue has been resolved with the party in question paying their balance. This issue was detected in previous audits but not corrected. There is no written policy on how insurance obligations are handled by the town. In this case, the issue stems from the fact that the employee did not receive wages, so their premiums were not withheld at payroll.

Beaudoin asked Jennings what he recommended to prevent this issues from recurring. Jennings recommended adoption of an official policy enforcing monthly reconciliation of the of the health insurance withholding accounts to catch these issues earlier.
