Snow Removal Contractors Wanted

The Town of West Newbury Department of Public Works (DPW) is seeking several snow removal contractors to add to their on-call fleet for the upcoming 2023-2024 snow season. The vehicles must be available with a qualified driver at all times; day, night and weekends from November 1st, 2023 to April 15th, 2024. The 2023-2024 snow clearing and removal equipment rates are listed below. If you are interested in applying, please email DPWadmin@wnewbury.org for the application packet and required documentation.

Trucks must be equipped with the following:

- a. Plow frame and plow, in good working order
- b. A minimum of one (1) Amber Warning light
- c. Cell phone
- d. Reflectorized ANSI Class II safety vest or jacket or better
- e. Valid Registration in vehicle
- f. Valid Insurance as stated below
- g. Valid Inspection Sticker

The Contractor and any subcontractor it uses shall purchase, furnish copies of, and maintain in full force and effect insurance policies in the amounts listed below:

Automobile Liability

Bodily Injury Liability: \$ 500,000 per occurrence
 Property Damage Liability \$ 250,000 per occurrence
 (or combined single limit) \$ 500,000 per occurrence

Workers' Compensation Insurance

Coverage for all employees in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws.
