STATE-WIDE ALERT - again: The Spotted Lanternfly is damaging to many species of trees and has recently been found in 2 locations in Massachusetts. We MUST stop its spread into our state by early intervention. It can be easily spread by plant stock at nurseries that were grown in infected areas. Be vigilant and carefully inspect all plants from local nurseries before you take them home. Please help by learning to recognize this noxious pest and its egg masses and report any sitings promptly.
