- 2. Tree City Award:
 - a. Signs and a banner were presented to BOS; plaque placed in the lobby of the town offices

- 3. Update Possible Project installation of shade trees at Page School and Action Cove playgrounds:
 - a. 10, 6-8 foot trees at each playground
 - b. Bartlett's to install the trees, Peter Dryden could be hired for watering
 - c. Fred is waiting on estimates so he can present to the Select Board.
 - d. Early estimate of \$5-7 thousand with installation and watering for the next couple years.
 - e. Celebration event should be scheduled after the trees are planted. This might include other committees and perhaps the Pentucket Environmental Club. Targeting 2nd weekend in September or 1st weekend in October for planting and celebration, depending on funding.
