

Minutes of West Newbury Tree Committee G.A.R. Memorial Library Thursday, August 18, 2022, 5:06 PM

In Attendance: Fred Chanania, Claudia Woods, Nicolas Forestall, Molly Hawkins, Kelly Scott

- 1. Update on the potential playground tree planting project:
 - Action Cove does not need shade trees; project would be limited to new playground at Page School
 - b. After consulting onsite with Bartlett's, 8 trees would be planted probably 2-3 inch red maples
 - c. Cost estimate received from Bartlett's around \$9,000 for trees and planting
 - d. Watering Services \$4-5000 per year new estimate to be sought
 - e. Warrant Article for the Town to be submitted due by 8/25 to BOS Fred to submit
 - f. Cost for the watering for spring 2023 can be included
 - g. Fred is working on a companion Notice of Intent to apply for a DCR Urban and Community Forestry Challenge grant to try to recoup up to 50% of the cost for the Town
 - h. Claudia will also look for other grant/funding opportunities
 - i. Spring planting if approved by Fall Town Meeting fall planting may not be funded in time
 - j. Motion to seek approval from Town for funding up to \$20,000 on this project, seconded and approved unanimously

2. Mill Pond Tree Trail Signs

- a. Aluminum/plastic composite, weather resistant from Coastal SpeedPro
- b. Tree Committees will need to officially request a bid for cost estimate for the 26 signs Fred to request
- c. QR Code on each sign will lead to an index page for all the tree species. Index page to be placed on Tree Comm website.
- d. Discuss about the amount of information on each sign and general consensus reached in favor of current tree sign design and more limited text
- Review of text on each sign bullet points favored; removal of references to state trees and substituting facts of more interest (e.g., birch bark canoes; something red on maples in all seasons)
- f. Review of how the signs will be attached with springs and screws
- g. Motion made and seconded to approve the signs as reviewed with editorial changes approved unanimously
- h. Next step is to contact Coastal SpeedPro for estimate
- 3. Update on State Champion Tree application no further information
- 4. Other items Not Reasonably Anticipated
 - a. Need for another committee person perhaps ask for an announcement from the Town
 - b. Update on status of Ash Tree Street survey report is still in draft form Wayne, Fred, and Bartlett's to discuss in next week or two; further action to be discussed
